

## **Open Out Arts – Leonardo VET program Ramshacklicious professional training in Le Fourneau, Brest 24th to 29th of may 2013**

May 24<sup>th</sup>

Arrival in Le Fourneau.

Discovering how the venue works.

Discussion with the technical manager about the technical conditions of artists residencies in France and about technical condition of performing in France.

Discover of the french notion of “creation residences” for a company in a place like Le Fourneau.

Installation for the show of Sunday 26<sup>th</sup>.

May 25<sup>th</sup>

Work in the “fabrication place” of Le Fourneau on Ramshacklicious new project.

Work with Leonor Canales, spanish director, author an performer settled in Brest (Company A petit Pas)

Identification of the need of the Ramshacklicious company in terms of artistical training and VET , and work on their creation process, their way of working collectively, their global and long term company project.

May 26<sup>th</sup>

Morning : Work on their new reation with the elements and advices brought by Leonor Canales.

Afternoon : rehearsals of their show “Fink Soup” which they perform on the evening.

Evening : Ramshacklicious performed their show Fink Soup in front of a french audience.

Feedbacks and discussions with the audience, with le Fourneau team, and with Lenor Canales.

Diner, informal exchanges.

May 27<sup>th</sup>

Morning ; intervention of Caroline Raffin (direction’s assitant in Le Fourneau) on the Street arts’ evolution since the 80’s, and description of an ongoing street arts landscape in France.

Debates and questions with the company.

Afternoon : feedbacks and work with Leonor Canales from the show Ramshacklicious performed the day before.

May 28<sup>th</sup>

Morning : intervention of Michèle Bosseur (Co-director of Le Fourneau) on the different ways of economic production of street art shows in France, and then work on the financial issues and production options for the incoming piece of Ramshacklicious.

Afternoon : Alex Nys (producer and touring manager for weveral street art company in France), did an intervention about touring street art shows in France and in Europe.

Assessment with the company about their capacity of touring on new markets.

May 29<sup>th</sup> : The Ramshacklicious company left Le Fourneau.
